- Each participant can participate as coordinator in only one Symposium.

## TRANSPORTATION:

San Felipe is connected to Santiago by Los Libertadores highway (Route 57) and by the Panamericana Highway (Route 5) and then Route 60. Both ways are about 110 kms of distance, and it takes nearly 90-120 minutes' drive.

Santiago has several car rental companies like Hertz, Budget, Europcar, Alamo, Avis, among others.

In addition, buses from Santiago to San Felipe depart daily from the Estacion Central. A round trip cost about \$ 5000 per person.

The 7<sup>th</sup> TAAS will provide a daily shuttle service from Santiago's airport to San Felipe, the first two days, and from San Felipe to Santiago's Airport, the last two days.





### ALTERNATIVE ACTIVITIES:

San Felipe's surroundings are rich in natural and cultural settings, which includes several vineyards and archaeological sites, among others attractions. Besides the fact that takes only a 2 hours trip to get to the Pacific coast between Valparaíso/Viña del Mar and Quintero.
